











## **2. STEERING WHEEL**

### **• TILT STEERING WHEEL**



To tilt the steering wheel up or down to the desired angle:

1. Pull the lever backward while holding the steering wheel.
2. Up or down the steering wheel to the desired angle.
3. Release the lever.

### 3. AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSION



#### SELECTOR LEVER POSITION

**P:** Parking, engine starting and key removal position

**R:** Reverse position

**N:** Neutral position

**D:** Normal driving position (Shifting into overdrive possible)

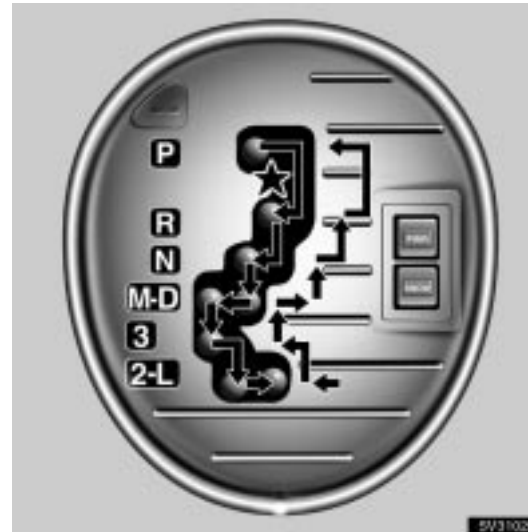
**M:** Position for manual shifting up or downshifting (Shifting into overdrive not possible)\*

**3, 2:** Position for more powerful engine braking

**L:** Position for maximum engine braking

\*:When the cruise control is being used, even if you downshift from "D" to "M", engine braking will not be enabled because the cruise control is not cancelled. For the operation to decrease the vehicle speed, see page 182.




#### OPERATION OF SELECTOR LEVER



★ Shift while pressing the brake pedal. (Ignition switch must be in the "ON" position.)




## 4. HEADLIGHT AND TURN SIGNAL SWITCH

### • HEADLIGHT SWITCH With the ignition OFF



	Parking, tail, license plate, side marker and instrument panel lights turn on.
	Headlights also turn on.
	Automatic light control

### With the engine started and parking brake released



	Parking, tail, license plate, side marker and instrument panel lights turn on.
